The Foundation Board approved grants of \$486,000 funding 25 organizations during Q1 2016. Grants ranged from \$600 to \$150,000 with an average grant just under \$20,000.

Of grant approvals, all but \$1,000 were for investment in West Michigan. \$100,000 was focused on the Roosevelt Park Neighborhood.

Approximately 46% of grants approved were for Christian organizations.
