Habitat for Humanity of Kent County	Multi-year support for the \$8M Imagine Campaign which provides 50 new houses in the Roosevelt Park neighborhood and another 50 new and rehabbed houses in other areas of the city. The campaign and grant covers 3 years. The campaign introduces a new Habitat model using third party financing.	\$300,000
Boys & Girls Club of GR, Youth Commonwealth	\$250,000 for the \$4.6M capital campaign to renovate the Seidman Club. The renovation will include a new kitchen supporting all locations. The grant will be recognized with the "Cook Cafeteria." This grant is a three year grant. Additionally, we provided \$25,000 for operations, focused on mental health work.	\$250,000
Bridge Street Ministries	Commitment to fund 10% of the Burton Heights Location Capital Campaign if they can match those funds soon. Grant is a two-year grant which we expect to pre-pay in year one so they can secure the intended building.	\$110,000

Blandford Nature Center	Under a contract with Kent County, Blandford Nature Center will provide some pilot programming at select Kent County Parks. To enable this and additional off-site programming, we provided funding to help purchase a van.	\$50,000
Critter Barn	The Critter Barn's actual project cost for the Small Livestock Barn increased \$400,000 due to some upgrades and cost increases. We approved \$50,000 as a top if off challenge grant if necessary funds are raised by 7/30/24.	\$50,000
Degage	Support for Heartside Landings as housing for women with complex care management needs.	\$50,000
East Fulton Units Foundation	Support for housing project serving those chronically homeless with complex care management needs.	\$50,000
San Juan Diego Academy	Operating funds for this Catholic school located just outside the Roosevelt Park neighborhood. Focus population is Latino.	\$50,000

Words of Hope	Support for the Words of Hope Center in Udampur, India. Focused on broadcasts and mission work.	\$37,500
Grand Rapids Art Museum	Funding for educational endeavors of the Grand Rapids Art Museum. Many interactive learning features are being developed to enhance visitor experience.	\$25,000
Kids Food Basket	General support for Kids Food Basket and the delivery of their services to schools in the Roosevelt Park neighborhood.	\$25,000
Literacy Center	Support for literacy and language education in the Roosevelt Park neighborhood. Work is focused on English as a second language with practical utility.	\$25,000
